The **CIVITAS SUMP-UP** and **CIVITAS PROSPERITY** projects are pleased to invite you to participate in a workshop dedicated to discussing the national SUMP implementation framework in Romania.

In 2017, the two projects conducted a joint needs assessment with cities from across Europe that asked their opinion on drivers and barriers to SUMP take-up. Following this, a clear need was expressed for a national framework to strengthen and increase the level of SUMP implementation.

The workshop will present the case for why it is necessary to create a national SUMP support framework, disseminate guidance and support materials offered by European projects (including SUMP-UP and PROSPERITY), and develop specific recommendations tailored to Romania's specific national profile and context.
